An ExpertClick account where you've already send a new release, so we've activated your RSS Button.

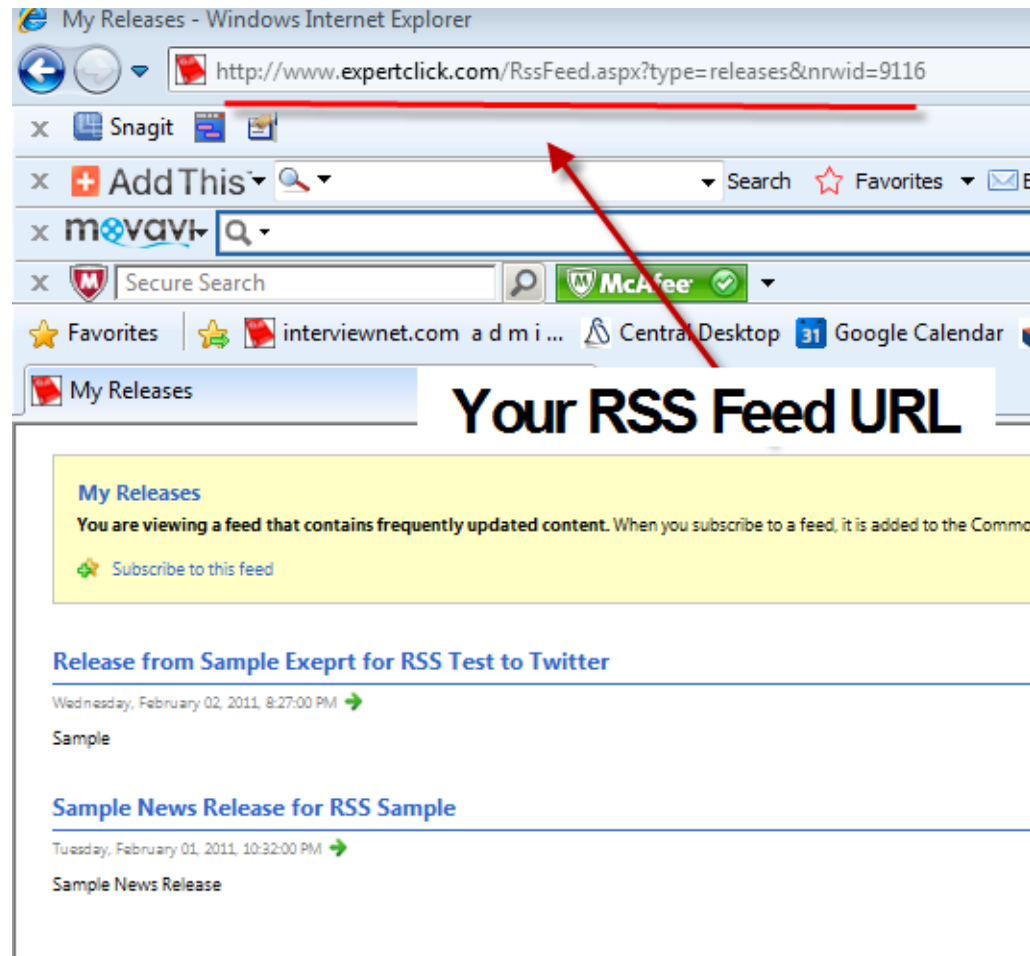
